Financial Update:

Updated projected expenditures based on 2017/18 actual with consideration of larger Pack numbers.

Expected 2018/19 expenditures to be \$15,605. Currently there are 62 active Scouts and an expected income of \$9450 from annual dues.

All expected expenditures were approved by the committee.

Dues to be paid in full by the Pinewood Derby or the Scout will not be allowed to race.

September Pack Meeting

This is our fall recruitment event. Fliers will be printed and distributed by the school. Council Office will print our fliers but we must give them a two week lead time and provide them with all the meeting details: time, location.

We will launch bottle rockets again weather permitting. Ben Anderson is building a new launcher for the Pack. Chris will contact Troop 13 to see if they could come and help with this meeting by having a tent set up station for the boys.

Tim and Lisa will have all Popcorn Sales material there for Scouts to pick up as sales begin September 15- October 13th.

Fall Fundraiser

New this year is that all Scout families will have individual family accounts created for their use for Scout events. It was decided that if Scouts sell \$435 of product then that will cover their annual dues for the year. All additional sales after the first \$435, Scout families will retain 30% into their Family Account. If a Scout does not sell \$435 in product the amount they sell will be prorated at 36% and that amount will be applied to the Scouts annual dues. I.E. Scout sells \$100 in popcorn, \$36 will be applied to the annual due of \$150 and the Scout will pay \$114 in annual dues.

Additionally it was discussed that top sellers for each den will be awarded a Pie in the face of their Den leader at a future Pack meeting.
